**Man's Raglan Pullover with
Crew or V Neckline.**

SIZES 34-44 CHEST
USING KAIAPOI SPUN GOLD
OR CHUNKY KNIT WOOL.

Man's Raglan Pullover with Crew or V Neckline.

MATERIALS

36 (38) (38) (40) (40) (42) ozs. "KAIA-POI" SPUN GOLD or CHUNKY KNIT.
2 No. 4 and 2 No. 6 Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit 34 (36-38-40-42-44) inch Chest. All round 38 (40-42-44-46-48) in. Length at centre back below band: 23 (23½-25-26-26½-27) ins. Sleeve seam: 17½ (18-18-18½-19-19) ins.

TENSION

7½ sts to 2 inches in width on No. 4 needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION VERY CAREFULLY.

ABBREVIATIONS

K, knit; p, purl; sts, stitches; tog, together; rep, repeat; inc, increase; dec, decrease; beg, begins(ing); cont, continue; patt, pattern; foll, follows(ing); fin, finishing; sl, slip; pssso, pass slipped stitch over; tbl, through back of loops; rem, remains (ing); alt, alternate.

BACK

With No. 6 needles, cast on:—
1st row: K 1, (p 1, k 1) to end.
2nd row: P 1, (k 1, p 1) to end.
Rep these 2 rows for 1½ ins, fin with a 2nd row.

Change to No. 4 needles and work in patt as foll:—

1st row: P.
2nd row: K.
3rd row: K 1, (p 1, k 1) to end.
4th row: P 1, (k 1, p 1) to end.
Rep these last 4 rows until work measures —

ending with a 2nd or 4th row.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off at beg of next 2 rows —

Now work as foll:—
1st row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt until 3 sts rem, k 2 tog, k 1.

2nd row: K 1, p 1, patt until 2 sts rem, p 1, k 1.

Rep these last 2 rows until there rem on needle —

Cast off.

FRONT (Crew Neck)

Work as for back until there rem ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Neck:—

Next row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt until there rem on left hand needle —

Cast off next —

Patt until 3 sts rem, k 2 tog, k 1. Cont on last set of sts, leaving sts for left side in the meantime.

Next row: K 1, p 1, patt to end.

Next row: Sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt until 3 sts rem, k 2 tog, k 1.

Rep these last 2 rows —

more, then if necessary, cont to dec at armhole edge only until 2 sts rem. Work 2 tog and fasten off.

With No. 6 needles, cast on:—	69	73	77	81	85	89	sts.
ending with a 2nd or 4th row.	13½	14	15	15½	16	16	ins
Cast off at beg of next 2 rows —	2	2	3	3	4	4	sts.
Rep these last 2 rows until there rem on needle —	21	23	23	25	25	27	sts.
Work as for back until there rem ending with a wrong side row.	39	41	43	45	47	49	sts
Cast off next —	9	9	9	11	11	11	sts,
Rep these last 2 rows —	4	5	5	5	5	6	times

FRONT (V Neck)

Work as for back until the first 2 rows of armhole shapings have been completed.

Next row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt k 2 tog, k 1, then turn and leave rem on a holder. Cont on the first set of sts, dec 1 st (as before) at neck edge every 4th row.

more, at the same time cont to dec at armhole edge every alt row until 4 sts rem (all sizes).

Next row: K 1, p 2, k 1.

Next row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, k 1.

Next row: K 1, p 1, k 1.

Next row: Sl 1, k 2 tog, pssso and fasten off.

Return to the sts for opposite side, sl first (centre st) on to a safety pin and leave in the meantime. With right side facing, rejoin wool.

1st row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt until 3 sts rem, k 2 tog, k 1.

Cont to match opposite side, reversing shapings until 4 sts rem.

Next row: K 1, p 2, k 1.

Next row: K 1, k 2 tog, k 1.

Next row: K 1, p 1, k 1.

Next row: K 3 tog and fasten off.

SLEEVES

With No. 6 needles, cast on and work in rib for same number of rows as for back welt.

Change to No. 4 needles and work in patt, inc 1 st at both ends of the 5th and every foll 7th row until there are on needle

then work straight until sleeve measures ending same patt row as on back at armholes.

Shape Raglan Top:

Cast off at beg of next 2 rows

1st row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, patt until 3 sts rem, k 2 tog, k 1.

2nd row: K 1, p 1, patt until 2 sts rem, p 1, k 1.

For first 2 sizes rep these last 2 rows throughout.

For sizes 38-44, work thus:—

3rd row: K 2, patt to last 2 sts, k 2.

4th row: As 2nd row.

For sizes 42 and 44 **ONLY**, rep the last 4 rows once.

Now for all sizes rep 1st and 2nd rows until 7 sts rem. Cast off.

NECKBAND (Crew Neck)

Join sleeves to front and back pieces, leaving left back seam open.

With No. 6 needles and right side facing pick up and k 7 sts. from top of left sleeve, then

around front of neck to opposite sleeve, then 7 sts across top of right sleeve and finally

across back neck. There are now

Work in rib as for back welt for 1½ ins, (all sizes). Cast off loosely in rib.

NECKBAND (V Neck)

Join sleeves to front and back pieces, leaving left back seam open.

With No. 6 needles and right side facing, pick up and k 1 st in from edge 7 sts from top of left sleeve, then

down left side of neck, p the centre st and mark this st with contrasting wool, then pick up and k

up right side of neck, k up 7 sts from right sleeve top, then

across back neck. There are now

1st row: P 1 and k 1 alternately until 2 sts from centre st, p 2 tog tbl, k 1, p 2 tog, then k 1 and p 1 alt to end.

2nd row: Work in rib until 2 sts from centre st, k 2 tog, p 1, sl 1, k 1, pssso, rib to end.

Rep these 2 rows until ribbing measures 1½ ins. Cast off loosely in rib, working a final set of deceasings in centre on casting off row.

TO MAKE UP

Join rem armhole seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Press seams very lightly.
