

SPRITE! FONTANA FEATHERWEIGHT Triple knit warmth without weight

CLASSIC V NECK PULLOVER

SIX SIZES-34 to 44 inch chest

PARAGON KNITTING NEEDLES

MATERIALS:

Fontana Sprite Triple knitting Chest or bust (loosely)

34 36 38 40 42 44 ins
1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th 6th size
16 18 20 20 20 22 ozs
1 pair each No 4 and No 8
knitting needles and 1 set of
four No 8 double pointed
needles.

CAUTION: Accurate results can be obtained only by using the FONTANA wool recommended.

MEASUREMENTS:

Length at centre back $24\frac{1}{2}$ 25 $25\frac{1}{2}$ 26 $26\frac{1}{2}$ 27 ins Sleeve seam (adjustable) 18 18 18 $18\frac{1}{2}$ $18\frac{1}{2}$ $18\frac{1}{2}$ ins

TENSION: $4\frac{1}{4}$ sts and $5\frac{1}{2}$ rows to 1 square inch.

Check your tension carefully and if it does not correspond with the tension given use a larger or smaller size of needles.

ABBREVIATIONS: K, knit; p, purl; rep, repeat; beg, beginning; inc, increase; dec, decrease; ins, inches; tog, together; st, stitch; sl, slip; alt, alternate; foll, foilowing; tbl, through back of loop; stst, stocking stitch (1st row k, 2nd row p); wl fwd, wool forward;

rsf, right side facing; M, main colour; C, contrast colour; kb, knit into back of st; pb, purl into back of st; patt, pattern; psso, pass slipped st over; cont, continues(ing); twist 2, k 2 tog then k into front of 1st st and slip both sts off left needle tog.

THE BACK: Using No 8 needles, cast of 7

THE FRONT: Work as Back to

Shape Ragian Armhole and Divide for V Neck as follows:—
Next row: Cast off

6 5 6 5 6 6 (1 st on needle after cast off), k **32 35 36 40 41 43** turn.

Next row: P to end.

Proceed on this group of sts, dec 1 st at armhole edge on next and every alt row, at the same time dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll

5th 5th 5th 4th 4th 4th row until

3 3 4 6 7 6 sts rem.

Cont dec at armhole edge only until 1 st rem.

Work

1 0 1 0 0 1 row. Fasten off.

Rejoin wool to rem group of sts.

Next row: Cast off 1 1 1 0 0 0 K to end. Next row: Cast off

6 5 6 5 6 6 P to end.

Complete to match other half, reversing all shapings.

SLEEVES: Using No 8 needles, cast on

Work in k 1, p 1 for 3 ins.

Next row: Rib

1 1 2 3 3 4 (inc in next st, rib 3) 8 times, inc in next st, rib to end

43 43 45 47 47 49 sts Change to No 4 needles and proceed in stst, inc 1 st at both ends of

3rd 5th 9th 5th 7th 7th and every foll

8th 7th 6th 6th 5th 5th row until there are

63 65 69 73 77 79 sts Cont on these sts until work measures

18 18 18 $18\frac{1}{2}$ $18\frac{1}{2}$ $18\frac{1}{2}$ ins from beg, finishing at end of a p row.

Shape Top by casting off

6 5 6 5 6 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of next and every alt row until

5 5 5 7 7 7 sts rem.

Work

1 0 1 0 0 1 row. Cast off.

Join raglan seams.

NECK BAND: With the set of No 8 needles, and with rsf, k 126 134 142 150 156 162 sts round neck including 1 st through back of loop or cast off st at centre V.

Work 7 rounds in k 1, p 1 rib, dec 1 st at each side of st knitted up centre V on every round. Work 7 more rounds inc 1 st each side of centre st above dec. Cast off very loosely in rib.

to MAKE UP: Press very lightly on wrong side of work, omitting the ribbing, with a cool iron over a dry cloth. Join side and sleeve seams, and sew in sleeves. Fold neck band in half to wrong side and slip stitch down. Press all seams.
